Cruise ships, large tankers, and bulk cargo carriers use a huge amount of ballast water, which is often taken on in the coastal waters in one region after ships discharge wastewater or unload cargo, and discharged at the next port of call, wherever more cargo is loaded. The introduction of these harmful marine organisms and other similar pathogens has caused major damage to many of the worlds' coastal regions and bio-diversities over the years.
