Candidates must be a college senior or fourth-year junior on schedule to graduate with their class. These strong leaders have demonstrated a commitment to excellence and worked hard for themselves and their teams during the season and beyond.

"If Johnny Unitas was still with us he would have been proud of the selection committees' belief, trust and great job identifying these college quarterbacks' that best represent what he stood for," said Mel Kiper, ESPN Analysis.
