The event will also provide a forum for carers and not-for-profit agencies suffering from 'NDIS frustration syndrome' to hear the latest on the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Guest speakers will cut through the confusion and provide real answers on the funding and support available.

Care Expo has been adapted from Care Central Expo which was a one-day mid-week event with a focus on disability.
