

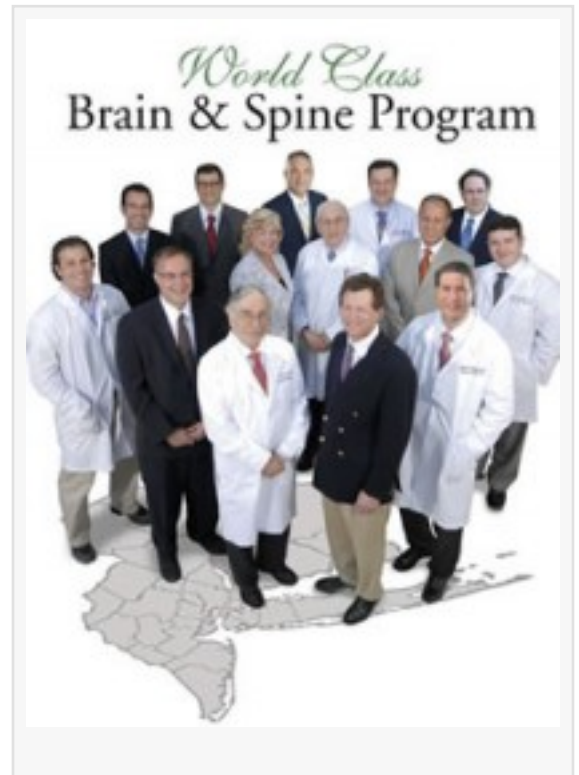
Seven Neurological Surgery, P.C. Physicians Recognized As 'Top Doctors' In New Directory
