

## Charity Event Raises Thousands for ACC School Improvement Projects

Hotel La Rosa hosts fundraiser to benefit poverty-stricken schools in Costa Rica

We were looking for an organization that had been proven to give real help. And we're Canadians. We've been able to help with earlier donation efforts through the ACC, but this event is the largest so far."

During the event, Hotel La Rosa offered free hearty lunches to all, and guests were invited and

encouraged to enjoy the hotel grounds and pool. The staff mingled with the visitors, local and foreign.

Hick believes the entire event has been a positive learning experience for the Costa Rican hotel staff and Expats.
