Back in 1985, he recorded with a famous producer. Butch Vig produced Nevermind by Nirvana, a number-one album of the year in the early nineties. Then, in 1986, he started a twenty-year sentence for a crime. That's when he started writing poetry. He took a

course in creative writing from UW–Extension. He wrote a few poems and people liked them, so he wrote more. There came a time when he used poetry as therapy. He would write two poems for every two weeks. And that beats writer's block. A lot of that stuff is in the book Best of Ken Jackson. He was released in '99 and put out a bunch of rock 'n' roll albums. He was also participating in a monthly poetry group for a while. He wrote one section of this book using a variety of student researchers.
