

Farrah Abraham Accepts Plea Deal Stemming from Beverly Hills Hotel Lounge Incident in June

LOS ANGELES, CA, UNITED STATES, November 2, 2018 /EINPresswire.com/ -- Getting arrested and charged with <u>Simple Battery</u> and <u>Resisting Arrest</u> in Los Angeles, California can be a daunting ordeal for most average citizens. However, reality TV star Farrah Abraham avoided a jail sentence, as is the case with most first offenders guilty of such crimes, by pleading guilty to Resisting Arrest. As part of the deal she promises to complete 5 days of community service, 12 hours of anger management, and agreed to stay away from the Polo Lounge at the Beverly Hills Hotel. In exchange the Los Angeles City Attorney agreed to dismiss the Simple Battery charge.

Some may recall the incident on June 13, 2018 where Ms. Abrahams was allegedly involved in a verbal altercation with other guests when the police were called, resulting in her arrest.
