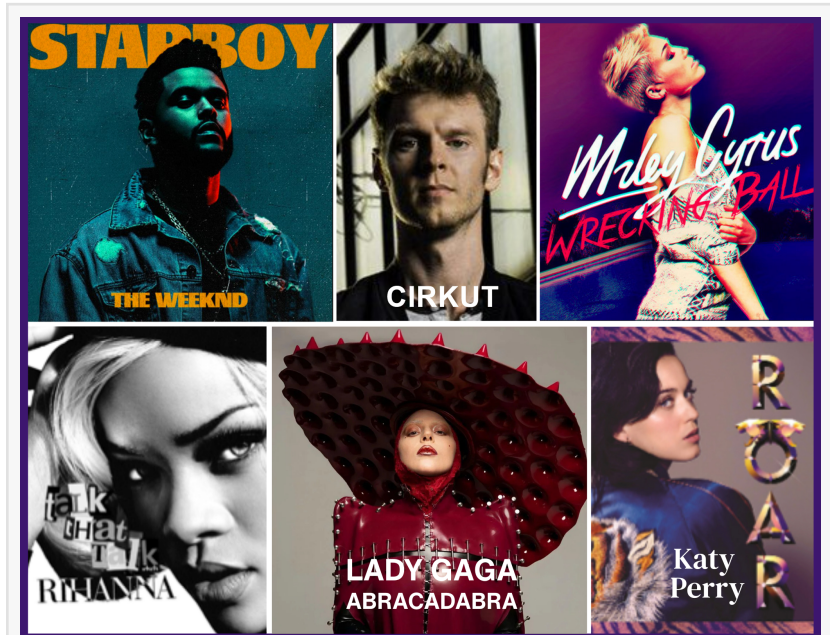


Harris Institute Alumni Nominated for 7 GRAMMYS
